

## Post Ordination Tertiary Study For Incardinated Priests

- 1) The Bishop's written permission is required for part time or full-time study for any:
  - a. Masters or doctorate, in a field they already hold a degree in
  - b. Post graduate certificate or diploma in any field
  - c. A course of study that the individual has no prior academic award in
- 2) Permission is sought by a written application to the Bishop, and must:
  - a. Demonstrate that the parish would not suffer during the time of study given that they are appointed to a parish and that is their full-time role
  - b. Demonstrate the benefits to the individual and to the wider Church such study would bring
  - c. Not be a course of study that would in the Bishop's mind be a conflict of interest either for the individual or their role
  - d. Provide a financial plan that:
    - demonstrates that they have applied for, and have, or have not received any government support or scholarships
    - how much they are personally willing to contribute
    - the gap they are requesting from the diocese to bridge costs
- 3) If approved, the individual would need to commit to:
  - a. Pay the necessary fees directly to the provider when due
  - b. Present an invoice to the Bishop's Office for the amount of support agreed upon after they have paid the provider
  - c. Provide a copy of the semesters course results with the invoice
  - d. Once the above three points have been completed, the invoiced amount will be reimbursed to the priest
