Notes from Nicki

This term has seen us meet with teachers from many of our parish regions to look at several issues including resources, safeguarding, declarations, expectations and recruitment for 2025. In addition, I have been meeting with school leadership teams to discuss Department of Education requirements and SRE.

Did you know:

- Schools are obligated to supply parents with an 'opt-in 'option in their Online Enrolment System (OES). This is especially important for parents enrolling their child for the first time.
- SRE teachers are entitled to an allocated teaching time of at least thirty minutes per week. 'Meaningful teaching time' does not include movement from one class to the next or interruptions from other staff or students during the lesson.
- Schools must provide adequate learning facilities for the delivery of lessons, including classroom and technology access.
- Schools are also obligated to notify coordinators of changes to the SRE routine, such as Christmas activities at the end of the year. Classes do not need to finish in early November! This is one of the most significant times in our church's seasonal calendar in which we prepare the children for the beautiful season of Advent. If you have been advised to finish SRE lessons very early in Term Four, please consider negotiating this. We are here to assist in this matter if you need us.

On another note, it has been such a joy meeting with many of you and seeing the wonderful work you do in the state schools. On a recent visit to Harrington Public School, I was welcomed by Anne Sandy and Catherine Richmond and of course, the lovely hospitality of the students and staff. Cathy reminded us all that "prayer isn't just talking to God, it's doing for God." What a great quote that we could all live by!

ADVENT RESOURCES


